

IB a Parent Booster
Meeting Minutes
January 8, 2019

Welcome – Meeting started at 7:05 p.m.

Approval of Minutes – December 11, 2018 minutes will be approved at the February 2019 meeting.

Treasurer's Report – Balance as of January 8, 2019 is \$10,707.42. Some of the disbursements in December 2018 are Teacher Appreciation gifts, Booster decals, and senior prom deposit.

Student Senate Report: Joanna Boykin

JoAnna Boykin reported that she has been working on selling tickets for the Lock In @ Lifetime scheduled for January 25, 2019. Discussions about the food took place including if we were using Passport Pizza again and that the students wanted a cake. Manuela and Shelley to follow up with Jill DeJesus about the pizza and the cake would be included on the signup genius along with the other items. Additional discussions took place regarding the senior gift to the school, which is disbursed from the senior budget. It was suggested that possibly more money be added to the \$250 amount typically spent on the senior gift. JoAnn to discuss with Student Senate.

Old Business

Jill DeJesus brought the lanyards and decals and discussed the problems with shipping caused by 4Imprint. The company compensated the Boosters for the mistake by offering a \$520 credit and the lanyards at no cost. Discussions took place about purchasing items for the senior class with this credit. Jennifer Carbary moved to use the \$520 credit for \$5 items for the seniors and it was seconded by Tim Neveau

Discussions regarding the Noodles and Co. fundraiser and how successful it was. The Boosters earned \$720.90. Discussions regarding the Cedar Pointe trip were tabled until the February meeting because the Chairs were not present.

New Business

A fundraiser at Teriyaki Madness was discussed. The original date was January 15; however, this would not give the Boosters adequate time to sell tickets so a suggestion was made to move the date to January 31. Tim Neveau is the chair of this event and will check with the restaurant and get back to us.

The Teacher Luncheon is scheduled for January 15 and the Chair is Brooke. Setup will be at 9:00 a.m.

Vendor fair discussions were tabled until January. Cedar Pointe trip chairs are Kelley Skillin and Christina Willson. Jill DeJesus will assist with the contact information from MST.

A suggestion was made to book another Noodles and Co. fundraiser on March 5, 2019 featuring a noodle eating /house attendance contest. We would also change the March meeting date to coincide with this fundraiser. The meeting date change was motioned by Jill DeJesus and seconded by Jen Carbary. All approved, none opposed.

Also another restaurant night was discussed on Tuesday, January 29, 2019 from 3:00-8:00 pm at Teriyaki Madness chaired by Tim Neveau. This restaurant would donate 20% of the sales for the evening.

The Group 4 project will take place Tuesday, February 26 at 6:00 p.m. Set up will be approximately 3:00-4:00, however, Jen Carbary will confirm with Ms. Pfannes. The chair for this event is Tracey Yaldo with the assistance of Joe Rice and Shelley Smith. Sandwiches will be provided by the boosters and a sign-up genius will include soda, water and fruit.
