Welcome – Meeting started at 7:00 p.m.

Approval of Minutes – October 3, 2018 minutes were approved including two changes with a motion by Manuela Valenti, seconded by Joe Rice; all in favor, none opposed.

Treasurer's Report – Balance is \$10,378.95. The teacher requests as well as Managebac were paid.

Old Business

Conference donations of food was a success and \$250 of dues was collected. A few items Denise Zanke mentioned for improvement were advertising needed for purchased food and maps of school. The teachers liked the booster table and appreciated the coffee and food.

Denise Zanke provided an update of the powderpuff game on October 13. The food tables and decorations were a big hit as well as the hairstyle table. Thanks to the Art Club for making the posters. Suggestions for next year are to decorate the water table and provide chalk to decorate for more school spirit.

Homecoming update provided by Manuela Valenti. The food and venue were very good. Also the decorations and centerpieces were great. Some improvements for next year would be to split the list of students between several people at check in because the line was very long. Also, if we use the same venue bring better tape (3m strips).

New Business

IBSOM conference was paid for by the Boosters with an approval via email for four people to attend.

Fundraising utilizing restaurants nights was discussed. Joe Rice indicated that Noodles & Co on Hall Road and Hayes will donate 50% of sales for a night in which we host an event. Jill DeJesus suggested a decorated Christmas tree raffle in which teachers decorate the trees. The Boosters would also decorate a tree with a possible movie theme. Risha Lewis to organize the Booster's tree. Jill DeJesus will follow up with Mr. Layson and Ms. Beebe as well as the teachers to determine their interest.

It was also suggested that we hold the December 11, 2018 Booster meeting at this restaurant. A motion by Jill DeJesus and seconded by Denise Zanke to change the Booster meeting location to Noodles & Co.

Mr. Layson asked for two turkeys to be purchased by the boosters, but a parent is donating them from their family instead. Kids will buy \$1 tickets to bowl, and the money raised will go to charity.

Merchandise sales was discussed and Jill DeJesus suggested a USB charger with carabiner and case. These would possibly be sold at the restaurant night. Joanna Boykin suggested lanyards and will get input from the students to gauge interest. Jill DeJesus will organize this fundraiser and a motion to approve a \$500 disbursement for materials was made by Joe Rice and seconded by Jill DeJesus.

A vendor fair fundraiser was suggested by Manuela Valenti. It would take place at the end of the school year on school grounds. The Boosters would sell booth space to vendors for games, activities, etc. Manuela will follow up with booth rental information.

Jill DeJesus provided an update on the Cedar Pointe trip in which MST expressed interest. It would possibly take place the Monday after the last day of school. At least 3-4 parent chaperones per bus would be required. The price would be approximately \$70 per ticket. Jill to follow up.

The end of the year picnic at Dodge Park is tentatively scheduled for June 14. It would require set up and clean up assistance. Dodge Park reservations begin in January 2019.
