

IB a Parent Booster Meeting  
**Minutes for 12/10/19**

**Welcome – Meeting started @ 7:00pm**

**Approval of Minutes** – November 12, 2019 minutes: L. Deal made a motion to approve without changes; C. Willson seconded. Vote is unanimous.

**Treasurer Report** – Some success with sending out an email request for payment of Booster donations. 3 people paid online through PayPal and one paid by check. Mrs. Beebe has agreed to send out an email on behalf of the Boosters. We could also do snail mail through the school but would need to cover all costs, including letters, envelopes, printing, and stamps.

**Student Senate report: Nic Bennett, on behalf of the Senate**

Nic is the chair of the Lifetime Lock-in event. The last midterm is now set for January 17, so Senate would like to host the event that evening. D. Zanke (not present) is the committee chair and is going to book the location from 10 pm to 5 am. There were problems last year with people leaving early. Mrs. Beebe has indicated that school leadership does not want people to leave early. Food needs to be rotated through the night or we need to find a way to keep the pizza hot. Parents could run out and get a second batch of pizza. Hot chocolate went over well. Need to set a price for tickets. Last year was \$35 the first week and \$40 the second week, but this year Senate will only have one week to sell tickets. Need to find out the cost of the venue before we can set the price. K. Skillin will pass along info to D. Zanke.

**Old Business**

Holiday luncheon for teachers went well. Food was much appreciated.

Noodles fundraiser is on Dec. 17 and the teacher decorated miniature trees will be on display. Raffle tickets are \$1 each, 6 for \$5, or 13 for \$10. 19 trees were purchased at 50% off (\$6 each) at Hobby Lobby and distributed to teachers.

**New business**

Logan Deal came to the meeting to request money for the robotics team, Crevolution. The team has 60 kids and 38 of them are UAIS students (54%). Because they have more freshman this year (36% of the team), the team needs to raise more money. Freshman only have to raise \$200 as opposed to \$600 for returning members. The team spends a minimum of \$40,000/year to build and compete.

Boosters budget includes \$2000 for clubs. Last year HOSA asked for \$500 and Quiz Bowl asked for \$800.

J. Rice moved to give robotics \$500; T. Neveau seconded. Vote is unanimous.

Prom will be March 28. The Panda Express fundraiser raised \$252.
